Geography

As Geographers we will:

- Name and locate the world's 7 continents and 5 oceans.
- Use world maps and atlases to locate Japan.
- Identify its 4 main islands.
- Contract the human and physical features of England and Japan and use basic geographical language.
- Identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in Japan.

PE

Our PE lessons will cover the safe use of the large apparatus, a variety of skipping skills, throwing and catching building up to team games.

Mathematics

As mathematicians we will be:

- Counting in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10
- Recognise the place value in 2 and 3 digit numbers.
- Recognise and know the value of coins.
- Read, recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20.
- Use multiplication facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Recognise and name halves and quarters
- Tell the time to the hour and half past.

Computing

- Explore websites linked to Japan safely
- Collect and present information in graphs
- Sort and classify data with databases.
- Use the internet safely.
- Use IPADs to enhance other subject areas

Music

As musicians we will:

- Use un-tuned percussion instruments to explore rhythms
- Sing and perform a range of songs
