In Literacy we will:

- Making marks using a variety of tools
- Read frequently to children, engaging them actively in stories, non-fiction, rhymes and poems, and then Develop vocabulary from books/rhymes.
- Provide plenty of opportunities for conversation, storytelling and role play.
- Modelling.
- In FS, Planning and recall questioning that invites them to elaborate.

In Communication, Language and Literacy we will:

- Follow adult cues to listen.
- Know behaviours for successful listening.
- Participation in stories
- Recall a range of simple nursery rhymes.
- Develop questioning skills
- Recall their morning

In Physical Development we will:

- Provide opportunities for play both indoors and outdoors.
- Forest School on Friday.
- Support children to develop their gross motor skills through core strength, stability, balance, spatial awareness, coordination and agility.
- Provide opportunities for directed and CIP Fine motor control tasks/stations.
- Repeated and varied opportunities to explore and play with small world activities, puzzles, arts and crafts and the practice of using small tools in Forest School.

<u>In Personal, Social and Emotional Development</u> we will:

- Support and manage emotions, develop a positive sense of self.
- Enable children to set themselves simple goals.
- Learn how to look after their bodies, including healthy eating, and manage personal needs independently.
- Make good friendships, co-operate and resolve conflicts.
