

### History / Geography

As geographers we will be learning about the history of The Romans. We will use maps to investigate where they came from and where they invaded. We will look at countries and continents across the globe. We will be able to recall key dates and times periods associated with the Romans.

### PE

We will improve our skills in quicksticks hockey. We will learn the basic strokes and how to control the ball as well as small sided games. In indoor PE we will have the chance to redevelop our gymnastic skills. Swimming session will also continue weekly.

### Mathematics

As mathematicians we will be learning about Mental skills in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division will be reinforced weekly. Understanding place value of larger numbers. In our computing lessons We will improve our research skills using iPads . We will also be constructing our own 3D houses using Google Sketchup—a program used by architects.

In music lessons We will learn to sing new songs and find out about Rock music and will explore how sounds can be made to create moods.

### Science

As scientists we will explore how bubbles are made. We will discover what effects bubbles, and if there can be a way of changing and manipulating bubble sizes through experiments.

### Literacy

In our Literacy lessons we will be studying Non Fiction work based around Roman facts and life-styles. We will write diary entries based on Roman soldiers. Spelling lists will be sent home weekly. Handwriting will be taught regularly and children will be expected to use joined letters in all of their work. The use of punctuation will be reinforced and the children will be taught how to improve sentence structure.
