- Clothing they will get wet and messy! Nursery jumpers are perfect for this \*Please note the colour is being phased out to navy blue and green t-shirt for 2022.
- Children should bring a named water bottle each day.

- Please dress your child in clothes they can manage independently, i.e. no belts, jeans or shoes with laces.

## **Starting Nursery**



- September start dates are staggered.
- Children will attend for either a morning or an afternoon session (See pack for details)
- 30 hour children will build up to a full day session by staying for a morning and lunch on the first day.
  - \* Some children may require a longer transition period which will be discussed with you if necessary.





## **Collecting your child**

- Children are collected from the nursery door at the end of the session.
- Please be on time.
- Staff need to be informed if a different person is collecting your child each day.
- Please introduce child minders / carers before hand if possible.
