

History / Geography

As geographers we will be learning about fantastic sports and exercise venues all over the world and in North Tyneside. We will use Google earth and photographs to help us describe the places we are studying.

PE

We will improve our physical fitness through a variety of fitness workshop including circuits. We will learn the benefits of warming up and cooling down and how exercise effects heart rate.

Mathematics

As mathematicians we will be learning about Mental skills in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division will be reinforced weekly. Understanding place value of larger numbers. Negative numbers and decimal numbers. Written calculation methods in all four number operations will be extended and these will be applied to problem solving and measures. They will be used in everyday contexts during science and technology lessons.

Computing

In our computing lessons We will improve our research skills using iPads and learn to use new filming and recording equipment to create adverts. We will also continue to learn about being E-Safe.

Music

In music lessons We will learn to sing new songs and find out about Rock music and will explore how sounds can be made to create moods.



Science

As scientists we will explore the human body and the role of the skeleton and muscles. We will spend time investigating ways in which we can maintain a healthy lifestyle. We will take measurements including length of limbs, heights as well as pulse rate when exercising and at rest.

PSHCE

In our PSHCE lessons we will be following a new scheme called 'Jigsaw' every Friday afternoon. The first topic is 'Being me in my world'.

RE

We will identify everyday signs, personal objects which hold memories, crosses and symbols and religious dress in different religions.

Art / DT

As budding artists we will develop our sketching and drawing skills with a focus on cartoon characters in the style of Keith Haring. We will improve our work by adding movement lines and learn to evaluate each other's work. We will also build a moving skeleton.

Literacy

In our Literacy lessons we will be studying Spelling lists will be sent home weekly. Hand-writing will be taught regularly and children will be expected to use joined letters in all of their work. The use of punctuation will be reinforced and the children will be taught how to improve sentence structure. Key texts will include "The Iron Man" and "Incredible sports" The children will write poetry, non-fiction reports based on topic work and learn how to write persuasively in leaflets and adverts.
