- Looking at the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction.
- Using different coins to make the same amount.
- Finding fractions of objects and numbers 1/2 1/4 1/3.
- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Solving simple problems.
- Describing properties of 2D and 3D shapes
- Reading scales.
- Using standard units of measure. cm, m, g, kg, ml, l

PΕ

Our PE lessons will:

- Develop simple hockey and cricket skills.
- Cricket– throwing, catching, bowling, batting
- Hockey- sending, receiving, stick control, travelling, shooting
- Applying skills and tactics in simple games.

Computing
