- Using multiplication and division • facts for 2s, 5s, 3s and 10s.
- Looking at the inverse relationship between • multiplication and division..
- Finding fractions of objects and numbers 1/2 1/4 1/3. •
- Solving simple one and two step problems, including giving change.
- Using simple coordinates –positional language . and direction.
- Reading scales.
- Using standard units of measure. g, kg, ml, l
- Reading the time to the nearest 15 mins.

PE

Our PE lessons will-

- Develop simple netball skills passing, attacking, defending and shooting.
- Apply skills and tactics in simple games. .
- Explore and develop athletics skills running over different distances, basic take off and land-

Computing

In our computing lessons we will learn how to:

- Make pictures move

- Create object based animation
- Use stop motion animation

Science

As scientists we will:

- Collect data to answer questions. .
- Describe observations using scientific language.

Geography/History
