- Using different coins to make the same amount.
- Finding fractions of objects and numbers $\frac{1}{2}$ $\frac{1}{4}$ $\frac{1}{3}$.
- Recalling and use multiplication and division facts for 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Solving simple problems.
- Describing properties of 2D and 3D shapes
- Reading scales.
- Using standard units of measure. cm, m, g, kg, ml, l

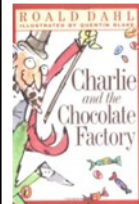

Science

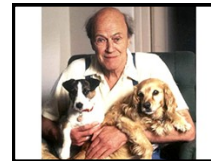
As scientists we will:
